⁶ He said, “**Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some.**” When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.



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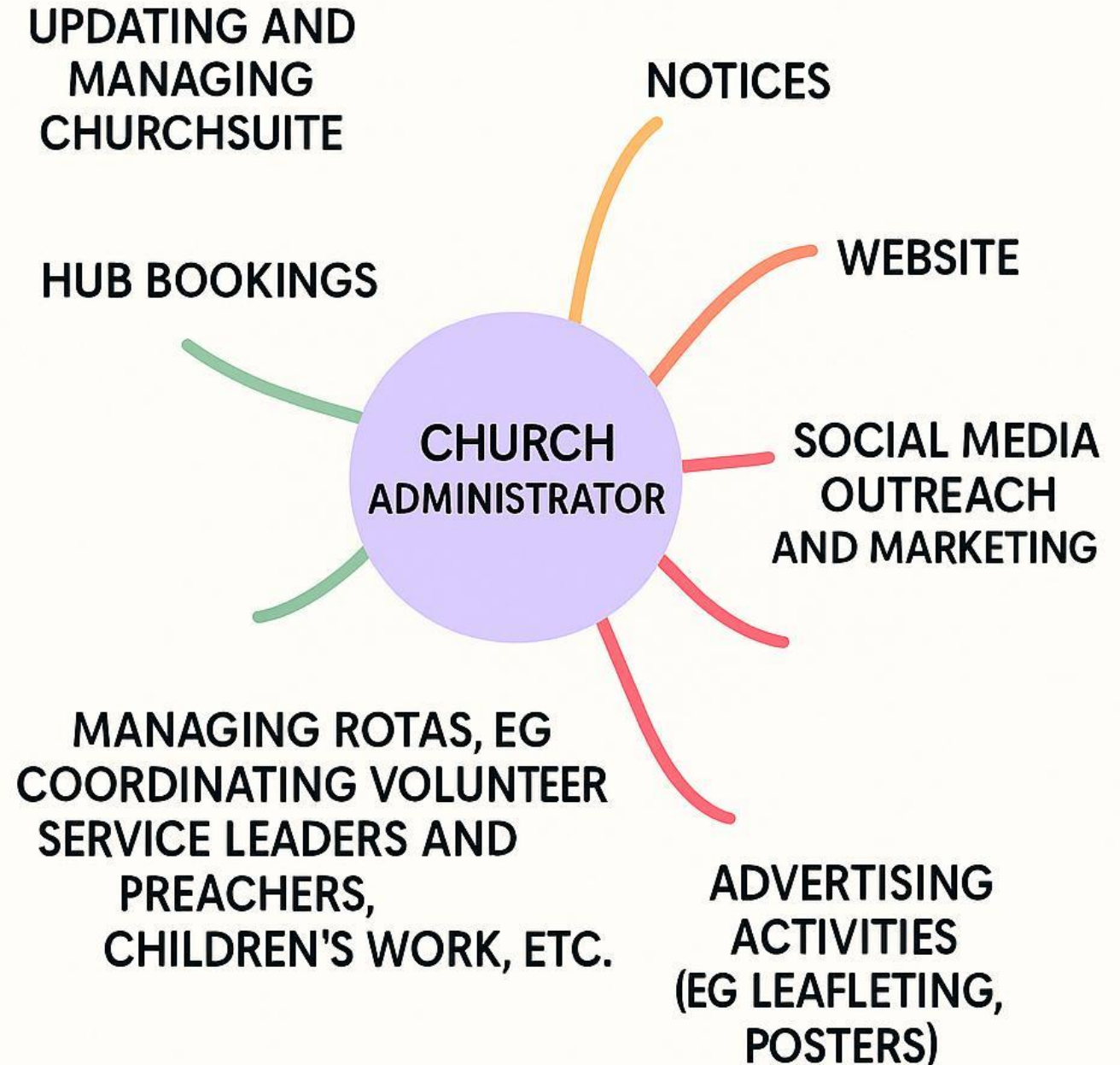
Where are we now?

- => no minister is the new normal :-)

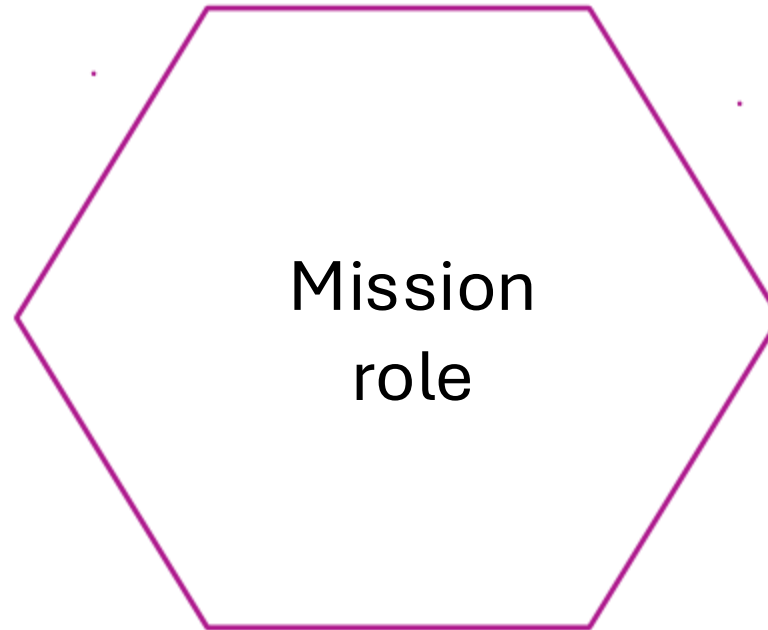

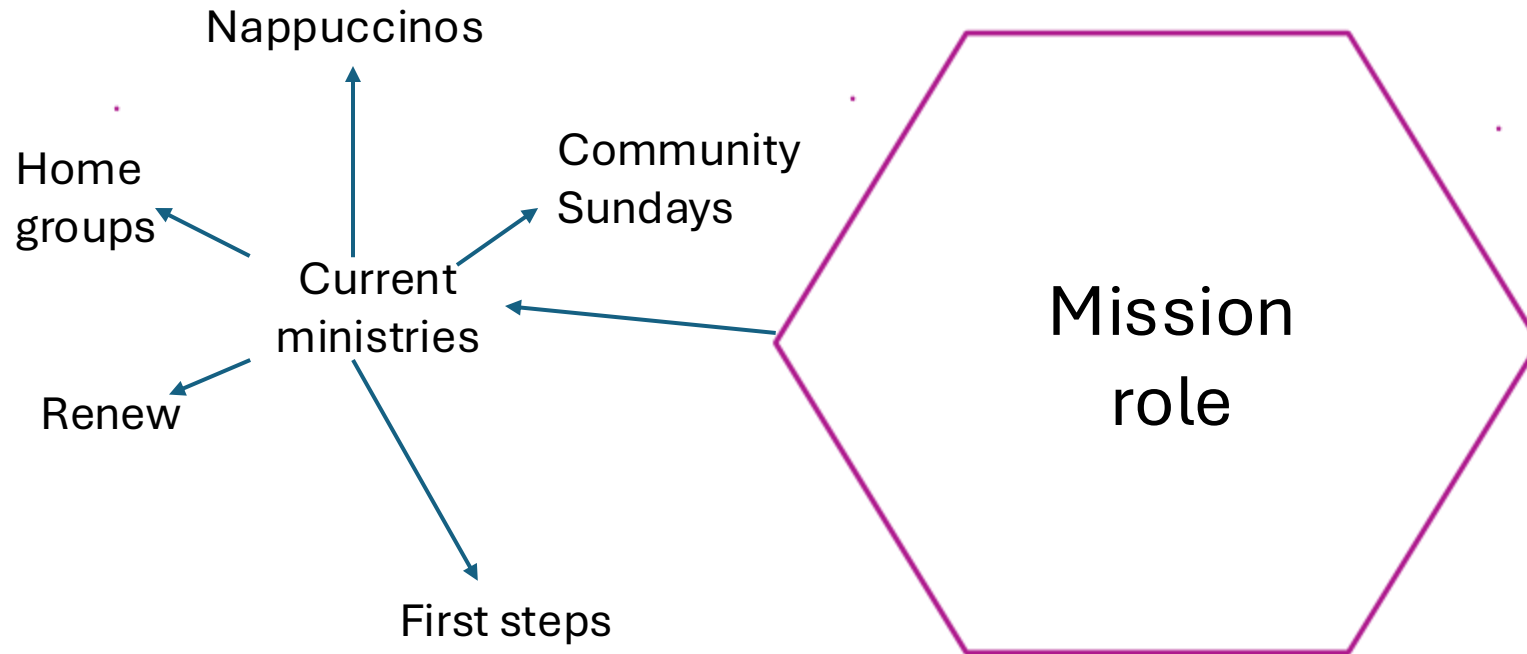
Administrator mind map



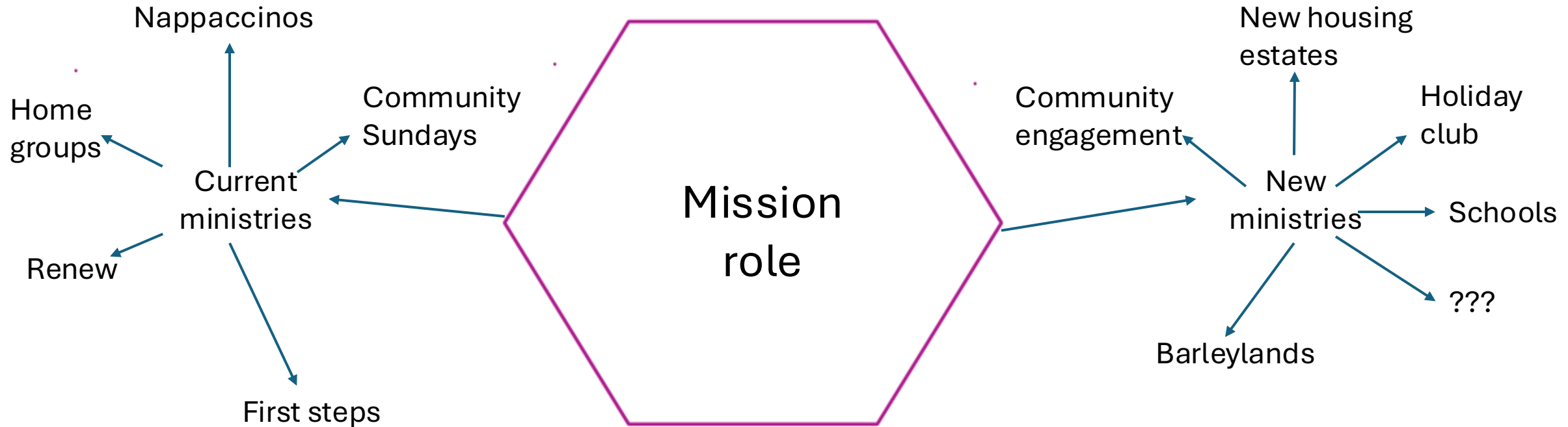
Potential role of Mission Person



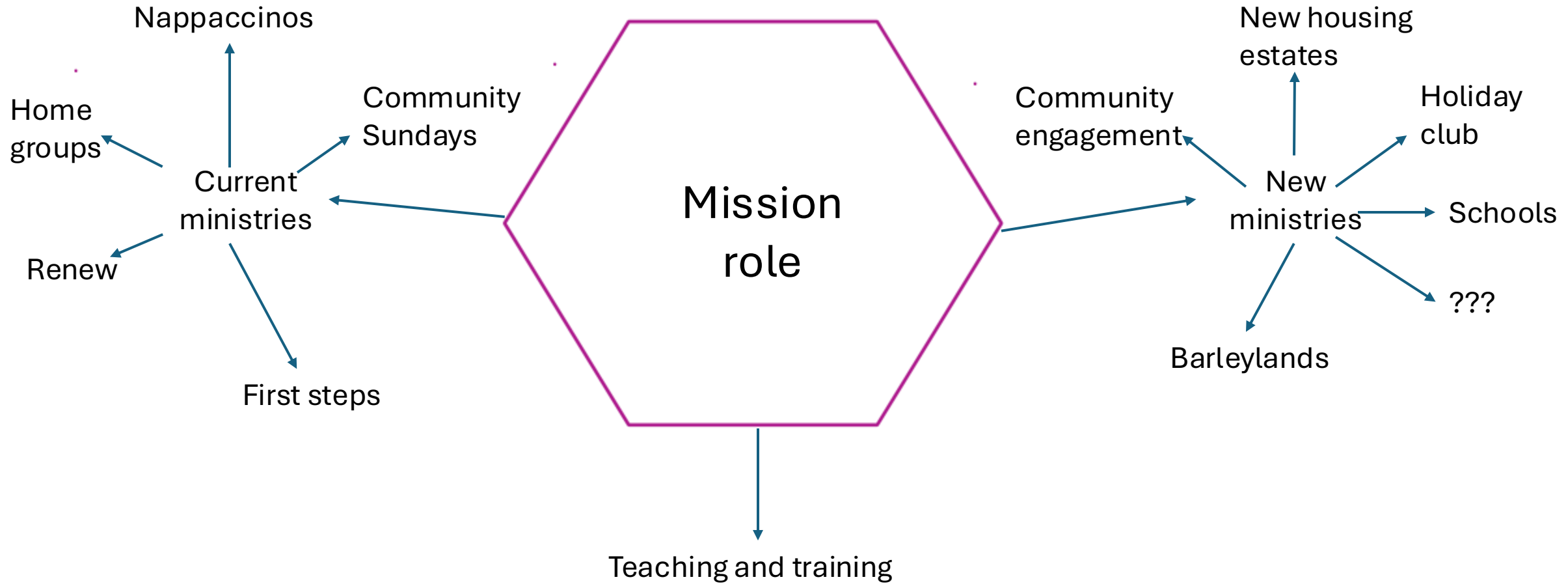
